Why is my gas bills so high....

There are a few things to consider.

- The burn increased for November because temperatures were -30 and colder
- The cost for gas & carbon tax below is an comparison from 2021-2022

2021 Gas rate

- Nov 2021- \$5.30
- Dec 2021 \$4.80

2022 Gas rate

- Nov 2022 \$5.45
- Dec 2022 \$5.90

2021 Carbon tax

- \$2.10

2022 Carbon tax

- \$2.63

Other things to consider

- Do you have high efficient furnace
- How well is your home insulated (Windows, doors, any drafts, age of your home)
- What are you burning (Garage heater, shop, In floor heating, hot water tank, etc)
- Keep track how often and how long your furnace is turning on. This will give better idea of how much you are burning.
- Is your furnace filter clean and your ducts cleaned
- Please ensure all fresh air vents on your homes exterior are free from build up (ice, snow etc) to ensure proper combustion of your gas burning appliances.



**NATURAL GAS
REBATE PROGRAM**

Albertans are getting extra help with their natural gas utility bills this winter.

From October 1, 2022 to March 31, 2023, most Albertans with natural gas service will receive a rebate from the Government of Alberta if Alberta's natural gas price is above \$6.50 per Gigajoule (/GJ).

The rebate applies to any Alberta residence or Alberta company with a natural gas usage under 2,500 GJ per year – a typical Alberta house uses around 120 GJ of natural gas per year!
